

## Position Announcement: College Students Wanted for Part-Time Work

We are looking for college students who can work part-time hours in the early mornings, late afternoons or in split shifts. Job requirements include (but are not limited to):

- Cultivating a welcoming classroom atmosphere where each child feels safe, secure and can develop a sense of belonging and value
- Developing a quality learning environment within a teaching team that is developmentally appropriate and actively engages children in the learning process
- Preparing and assisting with lessons, activities and curriculum tools that will serve to enhance each child's physical, emotional, cognitive, and social growth
- Establishing positive relationships with parents, children and co-workers
- Initiating classroom procedures based on early childhood learning standards
- Handling additional duties as designated by the Community Coordinator

Individuals holding this position will work within a teaching team to deliver beneficial early care and education services, including preschool and school-age care. Those that thrive within a team environment are encouraged to apply.

Our ideal candidate will possess:

- A minimum of two years of credits from an accredited college or university with a minimum of six semesters or equivalent quarter hours in courses related directly to child care and/or development, from birth to age six; OR
- Completion of the credentialing program of the CDA National Credential Awards System (The Child Development Associate, 1982) with current credentials as a Child Development Associate (CDA)
- At least one year of experience in the field of early childhood education preferred
- Strong oral and written communication ability and adaptability (as work requires interfacing with children, parents, teachers and other agency personnel)
- Strong organizational skills and a desire to be cross-trained in other positions
